## Young Environmentalist Awards:



The Lincolnshire Young Environmentalist Award 2018 was presented to St Margaret's C.E. Primary School on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, in a ceremony held at Whisby Nature Park in Lincoln.

St Margaret's was one of the seven finalists who were in the running for the award, in recognition of our ongoing environmental work, outdoor learning and wildlife habitats.

The judges were particularly impressed with our school's commitment to outdoor learning and our environmental work beyond the school boundaries. Every member of the school community is responsible for surveying the local woodlands, fields and water ways, and contributing environmental data which is fed into national surveys.

We hope that winning this award will encourage the children and staff at St Margaret's to continue their successful environmental work and appreciate their unique outdoor learning opportunities.
