 **SIGHT:** I see with my **eyes**. 


 **HEARING:** I hear with my **ears**.

Carnivore	An animal that eats meat
Omnivore	An animal that eats both meat and plants
Herbivore	An animal that only eats plants
Lifecycle	The stages plants and animals go through from birth to death
Offspring	A human or an animal's babies
Reproduction	Making more of something
Vertebrate	An animal with a back bone
Invertebrate	An animal without a backbone

<u>Vertebrate</u>	<u>Characteristics</u>
Fish 	Scales, live in water, cold-blooded, lay eggs, gills
Amphibians 	Smooth skin, live in water and land, cold-blooded, lay eggs
Reptiles 	Scales, lay eggs, cold-blooded, lungs
Mammals 	Hair or fur, warm-blooded, live births, lungs
Birds 	Feathers, warm-blooded, lay eggs, lungs

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
