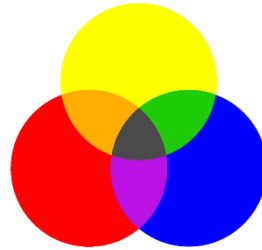
**Styles of Painting**

**Using our fingers and hands to create different paint effects.**



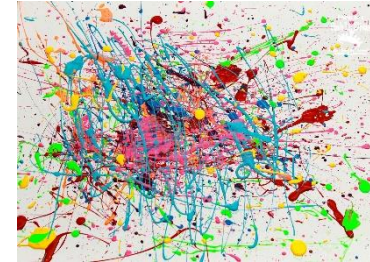
Hands and fingers can create different shapes to build a picture. The artist can feel the paint and allows them to use their imagination. It is also a lot of fun!

**Mixing paints to make different colours**



The **primary colours** of red, blue and yellow can be mixed to make new colours. Different paint brushes allow a **comparison** of thin and thick lines of colour.

**Drip Painting in the style of the artist, Jackson Pollock**



Jackson Pollock created a technique called **drip painting** which gave **texture** to his art. He painted with the paper on the floor.

**Key vocabulary**

***Paint effects***

Using paint to create different lines, shapes and textures.

***Drip painting***

Using different tools to drip and splatter paint onto the paper.

***Primary colours***

One of the three colours, red, yellow and blue, that can be mixed together in different ways to make any other colour

***Texture***

How the surface of something feels - is it rough or smooth, or soft or hard?

***Colour mixing***

Mixing colours together to create different colours.

***Comparison***

Deciding whether something is different or like something else.
