Styles of Sculpture

Using imagination and experience to create different sculptures using both manmade and natural materials.



Creating a 'sea monster' using recycled materials



Using clay to create a 'water' themed model which is then painted



Sculptures are 3-d models created from a range of different materials.

Working together to share ideas, experiences and imagination to create a sculpture of a sea monster. The sculpture can be made from a range of manmade and natural materials to create a 3-d model.

Clay is soft so that it can be moulded into different shapes. It will then harden so it can be painted.

Key vocabulary

Sculpture

A model or statue made out of different materials such as stone, metal, cardboard and clay

3-d (dimensional)

A solid object which you can see all the way around.

Imagination

When you imagine something, you make a picture of it in your mind.

Create

Making something out of different materials.

Modelling

Making a 3-d shape.

Materials

The items you use to make the sculpture which can be natural such as wood, stone or paper, or manmade such as metal and plastic.
