Beliefs that humans are created by God in his image.		What the Bible says about how Christians should treat others / live their lives. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reading parables (eg: The Good Samaritan) Revisiting the Creation Story – people looking after what God has made. Consider the actions of Adam and Eve and the choices they made. To understand that humans are created as equal and special. Looking at Jesus' teaching - to treat each other as special and equal eg: The Greatest Commandment (Mark 12:30-31), the Golden Rule (Matthew 7:12) 	
Belief that humans are created to look after God's creation.			
Belief that humans should love God and love their neighbour as themselves.
