<b>5 Pillars of Islam</b>		<b>Islam</b>	The religion of Muslims.
<b>Faith</b>		<b>Muslim</b>	Someone who believes in Islam and lives according to its rules.
<b>Prayer</b>		<b>Faith</b>	A particular religion, for example Christianity, Buddhism, Hinduism or Islam.
<b>Charity</b>		<b>Fasting</b>	Not eating food.
<b>Fasting</b>		<b>Founder</b>	The person who started or caused something to happen.
<b>Mecca</b>		<b>Religion</b>	Belief in a God or Gods.
		<b>Charity</b>	An organisation which raises money in order to help people who are sick or very poor, or who have a disability.
		<b>Prophets</b>	Special messengers.
		<b>Allah</b>	The name of God in Islam.
		<b>Prayer</b>	The activity of speaking to God.
		<b>Muhammad</b>	The founder of Islam.
		<b>Mecca</b>	A city in Saudi Arabia where the Prophet Muhammad was born. All Muslims face towards Mecca when they pray.
		<b>Mosque</b>	The building where Muslims go to pray.
		<b>Ramadan</b>	The 9 <sup>th</sup> month of the Islamic calendar is Ramadan. The Islamic calendar has 12 months in total.
		<b>Qur'an</b>	Muslim holy book.
