Variables	The things that are changed in the experiment.



Newton meter		A device used to measure newtons (N).
Pull force		To move an object towards oneself.
Push force		To move an object away from oneself.
Water resistance		A force that is caused by water with the force acting in the opposite direction to an object moving through the water.
